DOVE® Chocolate believes that children's education is one of the most important factors in improving outcomes for communities and individuals. That's why as part of Cocoa For Generations, we've committed US \$ 3.3 million over five years to work with the Jacobs Foundation to help transform educational opportunities in cocoa-growing regions of the Côte D'Ivoire. In addition, our Protecting Children Action Plan aims to eliminate child and forced labour in our cocoa supply chain.

FARMING SUSTAINABLY

Sustainable growth for cocoa and communities. Through Cocoa Development Centers, DOVE is providing agricultural sustainability education and training, helping to improve farming practices, crop yields, and communities in Cote D'Ivore.

Ensuring farmers are working with the latest and best techniques is essential to help them work efficiently and sustainably – for their families and for the future. As part of Cocoa For Generations, we aim to achieve a deforestation-free supply chain for cocoa we source by 2025. We want to help farmers grow more cocoa on existing farmland without further expansion of land use, and we are committed to supply-chain transparency, ensuring our farmers receive more money for their product. We also fund a network of research centres, farms and universities, to develop more efficient and sustainable farming methods.

ENABLING ENTREPRENEURS

Since 2015, DOVE® Chocolate has been working with humanitarian organization CARE to help women cocoa farmers in Côte D'Ivoire improve their businesses, family lives and communities by gaining financial independence.
